




TF card slot




Getting started

Card installation/replacement:

Install the storage card if it is not being preinstalled. Use the supplied triangle opener to remove the O-ling by rotating counter clock-wise, then remove the cover glass to access the card slot.

Supported micro SD card: 2G/4G/8G/16G/32G.



Charging the battery:

It is recommended that you fully charge the preinstalled battery before first use.

- Connect your flashlight to the power adapter using the USB cable provided.
- 2). Plug in the power adapter to an electrical outlet to start charging the battery.

As the battery is being charged, the LED indicator shows green and blinks. When the battery is fully charged, the indicator turns to solid green.



Basic Operations

To turn the unit on, firmly press ||utton till the green LED indicator turns on, release the button, the indicator turns to solid blue

To turn the unit off, firmly press hutton till the LED indicator turns off

When the LED indicator shows solid blue, press

button once to start video recording. The LED turns to green and blinks.

To stop video recording, press button once again, the indicator turns to solid blue.

When the recording duration exceeds 15 minutes, the video data will be saved once, and then go on recording automatically.

720P/480P Switch: Factory default set: 720P.

To switch between 720P/480P Mpress the and buttons once in same time.



When the LED indicator shows solid blue, press button paper to take a photo, the indicator blinks 4 times and turns to solid blue.

When the LED indicator shows solid blue, press button to start sound recording, the indicator shows green and blinks.

To stop sound recording, press the **M**utton once again, the indicator turns to solid blue.

You need to copy music files to your storage card first. Connect the flashlight to your computer, create a folder named Music inside the storage card of your flashlight, then copy the MP3 or WMA files to this folder.

Music Playback

Switch to music mode: When the indicator

shows solid blue, press button once to enter music mode. The indicator turns off, music goes out from the speaher. To quit the music mode, press button once again. the indicator turns to solid blue.

Select Song: ppreside or button once to select next or previous song.

Volume Control: Press an hold button to increase the volume, Press and hold button decrease the volume.

* You • In click button to pause or continue the music playback.

To power on the light, press "utton once.

Next, the "button can be pressed to move from light settings: Hight light, Low Light, Safety Strobe(S.O.S.), and OFF.

Setting date and time:

 Connect the flashlight to your computer, the storage card is recognized as a removable disk on your computer.

2). A sample file **Time.txt** is included in the product CD-ROM, copy this file and paste it into the root of the removable disk. Open the file, correct the date and time, and then save.

- 3). Unplug the flashlight from the computer.
- 4). Firmly press button to turn your flashlight on, the new date and time is updated.

Fault reset:

When a fault occurs, you can try the reset function to solve the fault. The Reset button is inside the Reset hole. Use a needle (or a toothpick) insert into the reset hole to press the Reset button once.



 To avoid data lose or malfunction, do not connect the flashlight to your computer when it is on recording status.



- The product is not waterproof type. Water may cause trouble for the product.
- 3) Besides that the cover glass can be opened by triangle opener, never attempt to open the other parts or remove any internal components. Doing so can potentially damage the flashlight and void the warranty.
